PASCHAL PRECEPT: Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. Between Ash Wednesday (6<sup>th</sup> March) and Trinity Sunday (16<sup>th</sup> June) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT:** Is celebrated on Thursdays during Lent *commencing at 7.30pm*: *11<sup>th</sup> April.*
