The Weekend Masses will be covered by a Supply Priest.

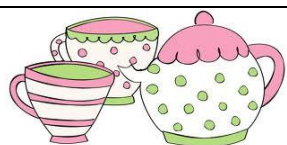
Tuesday to Friday (inclusive): Liturgy of the Word and Holy Communion Services will continue to be at 9.30am.
