The Parish Pastoral Council shares the responsibility for building a vibrant community that is embedded in the Eucharist and built on faith, hope and charity.

Aware that Baptism is a call to holiness; our Parish Pastoral Council is fired with the love of faith in Jesus and service in the Church. Therefore the Council prays together and discusses issues pertinent to the growth in faith, hope and charity of the Parish and discerns the various needs, hopes and gifts of the Parish Community in the areas of faith formation, evangelization, liturgy and worship, stewardship and outreach.

The Parish Pastoral Council is an advisory body to the Parish Priest. Members are baptised people in full communion with the Church and participate fully within the life of the Parish. Members will normally hold office for two years.
