

Importantly, we are again collecting food and personal items for the Nagle Centre, who provide warm meals to the homeless, hungry and lonely people of our area. **The Centre specifically needs: Tinned tuna, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned baked beans, Tinned fruit, Milk powder, Custard powder, Hot chocolate, Plain flour, Self raising flour, Beef stock cubes and any herbs & spices.** Nappies are also a necessity and would be welcome as would be new blankets and socks.

**BISHOP PETER INGHAM'S MESSAGE ON THE ROYAL COMMISSION WOLLONGONG PUBLIC HEARING**

Bishop Peter Ingham has released a pastoral message to the people of the Diocese of Wollongong informing them that the Diocese has been called to appear before the Royal Commission in a public hearing in Sydney for two weeks commencing Tuesday 24 June 2014. Bishop Ingham, together with others in the Diocese, has been asked to appear at the public hearing.

Bishop Ingham has reaffirmed that any person with a complaint of mistreatment or abuse is strongly urged to come forward to the appropriate authority. If the complaint is of a criminal nature, please call the Police Assistance Line on 131 444. You are also encouraged to contact the Royal Commission Support Line on 1800 099 340. If you need assistance with this you can contact the Diocese on 1800 225 922.

Bishop Ingham invites all people of the Diocese to join him in prayer that our combined efforts may lead to the greater protection of children and to justice and assistance with healing for victims of sexual abuse.
